**22 OUTDOOR CLASSROOM**

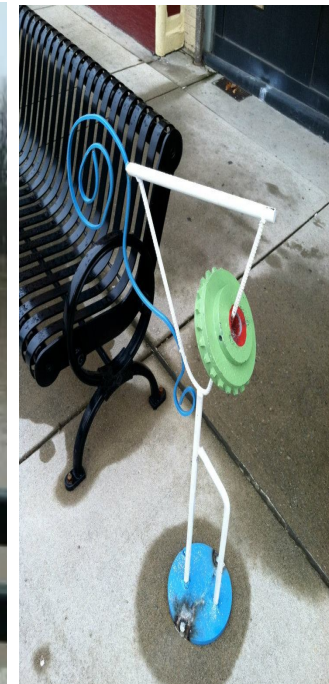
Lincoln Elementary School is home to a lot of school children every year. The downtown even has a crosswalk guard during peak school hours. Be sure to see this exhibit!

## How To Participate in the Survey

StickAround Downtown Findlay is designed for everyone in our community. We hope that people will come downtown and find the exhibits fun, as well as educational. The survey can be taken using a smartphone, a guided tour, or the old fashioned paper version. Sometime around March a virtual tour/survey will be available on HRPC's website. It's not the same, but it's as close to the real thing as we can make it.

### Have a Smartphone?

Anyone with a Smartphone can start taking the survey at any point. The phone should be equipped with a camera and also have access to the internet. Each exhibit has an instructional card, just follow the instructions. Use your smart phone to scan the QR code and you will be taken to the survey question for that exhibit. There will be a few questions that we hope you will answer. We promise there are no more than 5 at any exhibit.



### Borrow A Digital Tablet for Free!

You can use one of our digital tablets if you would like. Various participating businesses have tour schedules posted in their businesses. Tours will occur on a regular schedule but individual tours can be arranged by calling HRPC at 419-420-4774. Tours can be as short as 30 minutes or as long as 2 hours, it your choice!



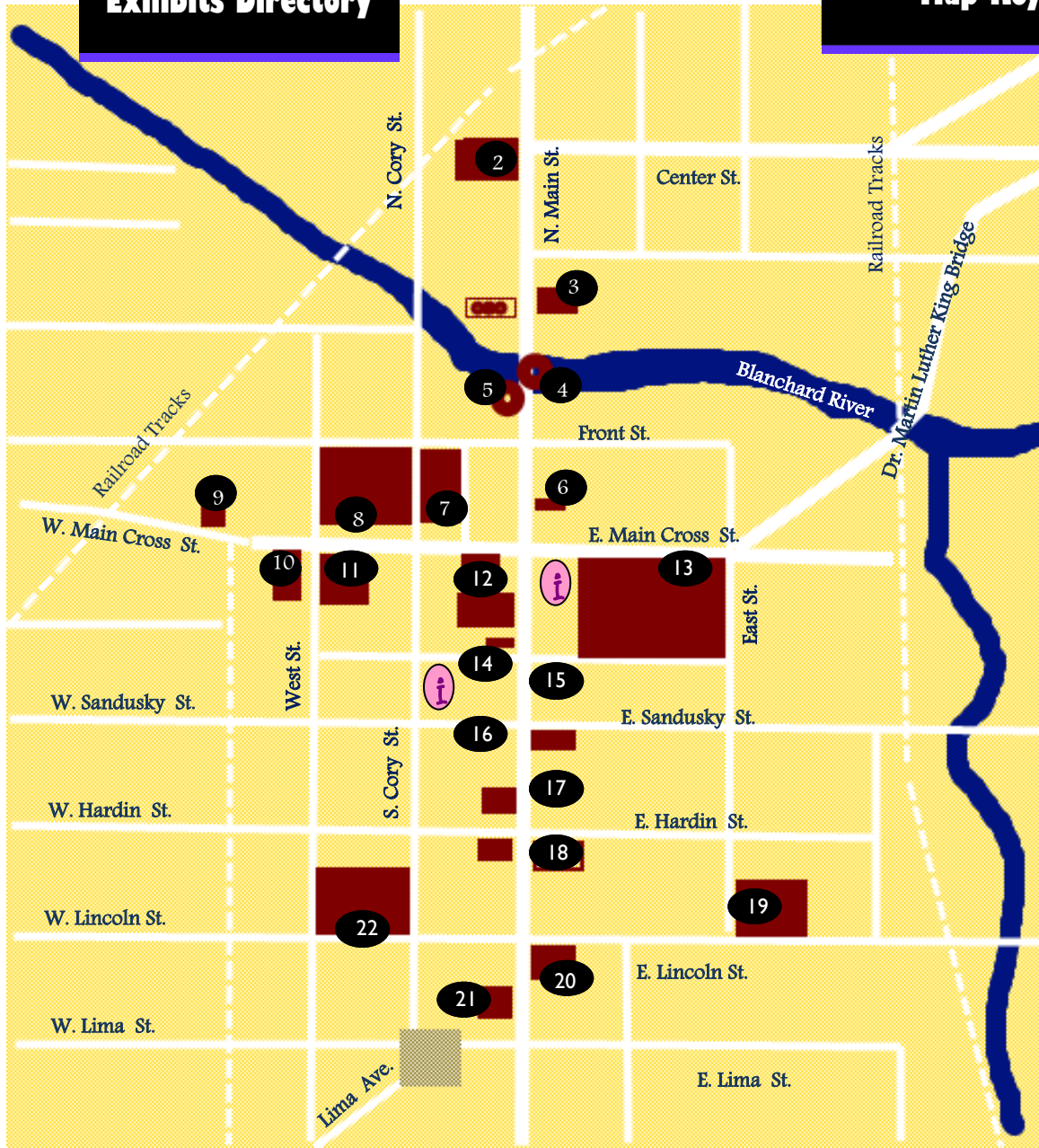
### 22 Exhibits

The main focus of our study are Findlay's two main streets, which funny enough are BOTH named MAIN STREET!. New people in town always comment on the intersection of North Main, South Main, East Main Cross and West Main Cross. With the exception of the exhibit at the University of Findlay, the 22 exhibits extend from the Veterans Memorial on North Main (North) to Fire Station No. 1 on South Main (South), and from LaRiche Chevrolet on E.
